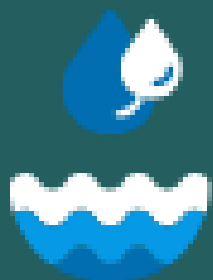
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Cancer

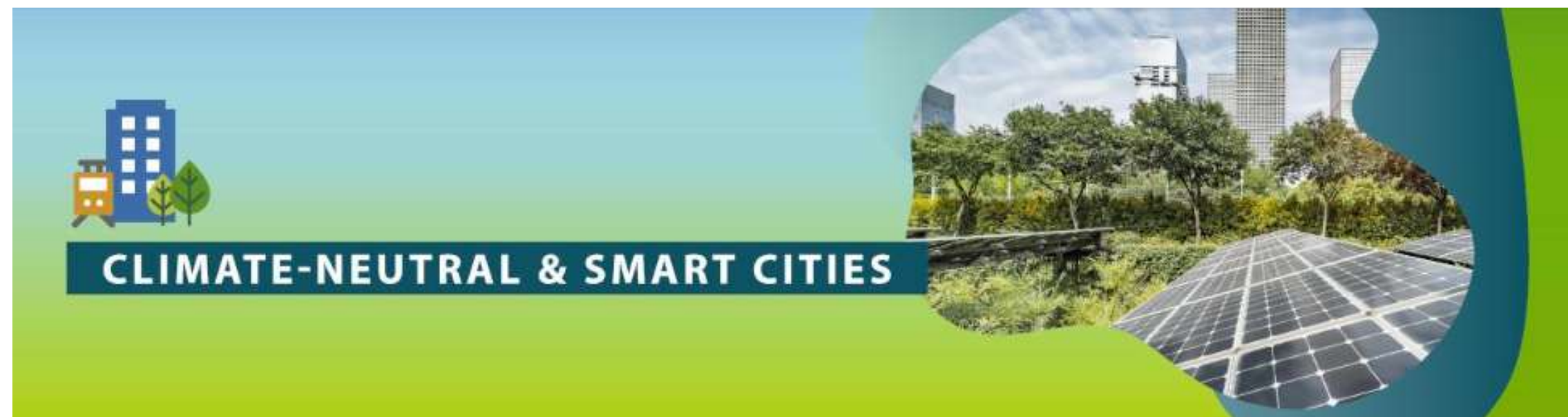
Climate-neutral and smart cities

CETP – Clean Energy Transitions Partnership

The CETPartnership aims to empower the clean energy transition and contribute to the EU's goal of becoming the first climate-neutral continent by 2050.

Call 2025: is divided into 9 thematic modules

Opening of the call: June 11, 2025

Deadline for 1st round: October 9, 2025

Deadline for 2nd round: March 12, 2026





DUT – Driving Urban Transitions to a Sustainable Future

The DUT Partnership funds transformative research and innovation projects to accelerate urban transitions towards a climate neutral and resilient future for all.

Call 2025: The topic reflects the objectives of the partnership within the framework of 3 thematic areas (the 15-minute City (15mC) Transition Pathway, the Circular Urban Economies (CUE) Transition Pathway and the Positive Energy Districts (PED) Transition Pathway.)

Opening of the call: September 1, 2025 Deadline for 1st round: November 17, 2025

Deadline for 2nd round: April 23, 2026

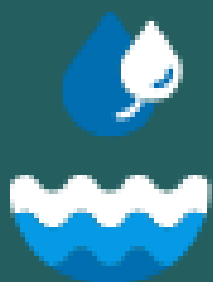


A Soil Deal for Europe

The Soil Mission aims to establish 100 living labs and lighthouses by 2030 to lead the transition towards healthy soils by:

- ✓ acting as leaders in sustainable soil management
- ✓ co-create knowledge

The Mission aims to restore the health of oceans, seas, and inland waters by 2030 through innovation, engagement, and sustainable investments.
