Aims of the Mission

The Cities Mission will involve local authorities, citizens, businesses, investors as well as regional and national authorities to

- 1. Deliver 100 climate-neutral and smart cities by 2030
- 2. Ensure that these cities act as experimentation and innovation hubs to enable all European cities to follow suit by 2050





Main elements



Who? All cities wanting to learn and embark on a journey towards climate neutrality, at any stage of their journey. Depending on their climate commitment, they will have access to different levels of support.



What? Tools, resources, and approaches developed by Mission Cities, including the Climate Transition Map and exclusive peer learning opportunities (site visits, twinnings, learning courses)



How? A mix of online and in person learning activities, starting from the Portal and including online groups, study visits, twinning with Mission Cities, and engagement at national/regional level.

Key resources translated in multiple EU languages: All essential materials will be translated to ensure accessibility for diverse participants.



Certification: Completing all 6 core sessions grants the participant with a **certification of completion**, and also unlocks dedicated feedback sessions with NetZeroCities experts.



Spotlight Sessions: After the core session of each module, learners can take these optional sessions to explore specific topics in depth, complementing the knowledge acquired during the core sessions.



Flexible Participation: Participants can also take modules and sessions individually if they wish to focus on specific topics only, but *certification* requires the completion of the 6 core sessions.



Key elements of national ecosystems that advance the EU Cities Mission

- Cities form a community of practice for joint collaboration to overcome challenges and boost opportunities
- Real multi-level governance across local, regional and national authorities to support cities in their climate neutrality work
- Real multi-stakeholder collaboration across public authorities, industry, academia, social sector and civil society
- Mission approach for climate neutral cities, following the EU Cities
 Mission methodology
- Facilitating organisation with a strong mandate to coordinate the work at national level in order to advance the implementation towards climate-neutral cities





Examples of existing national ecosystems that advance the EU Cities Mission:

- Engaging with Twin Cities facing similar climate challenges, while gaining fresh perspectives, innovative ideas, and tailored solutions to accelerate their climate neutrality plans.
- Enable Twin Cities to identify actionable and replicable climate solutions and prepare for their local implementation in close coordination with their Mission City counterpart


