- Inaugural edition officially launched in January 2025 by the Mayor Matus Vallo

Energy

Goal: increased energy effectiveness and development of renewable sources of energy:

- Reduce energy consumption by at least 10% and/or
- Increase production from renewable sources to at least 5%



Sustainability

In case companies choose only one of the two energy goals, the participants can select one of these sustainability-development areas:

- Parking lots,
- Greenery,
- Waste,
- Mobility/logistics
